- Draft Sheffield Transport Strategy has been published and on Sheffield City Council website

- 4 Main themes – People & Communities, Environment, Health & Wellbeing and the Economy
- The plan recognises that the car will remain the mode of choice for people
- PK's summary document is attached to the minutes for reference
- The plan has future considerations built into the strategy – Home working and cleaner vehicle technology
- People & Communities – Growing population and ageing population
- Environment – Nitrogen dioxide levels are above the legal limits in areas in Sheffield
- Health & Wellbeing – Sheffield's life expectancy is below the national average
- Economy – Under national average on GVA per head
- Possible Interventions – Workplace parking levies, congestion charging, quality bus corridors, cycling, park and ride and inner ring road improvements
- Action – Will require support and education to drive change
- Outcome – To organise an event that will be hosted at the Town Hall – Present headline questions that we want answering – November timescale for delivery
